
Our constant concern is to protect the environment taking inspiration from the principles of **preventing pollution through continuous improvement**.

Health, Safety and Environmental Policy represents our commitment to:


- ✓ **Respect laws thoroughly**, relevant regulations and commitments we have undertaken regarding environmental safeguard, health and safety of our workforce;


Policy and objectives are explained to the workforce and made them available to all parties concerned in order to create awareness and to promote a proper commitment to meet aims previously set up.
